Project: Lifeguard Training Program

Description: This program offers free lifesaving and lifeguard training to eligible youth and young adults from Western Region 2.

The program encompasses two streams:

- 1. Mainstream: Eligible youth apply to have fees waived for regularly scheduled lifesaving and lifeguard training held at the Frank J. Dunn Swimming Pool and/or Kinsmen Water Park.
- 2. Group: Eligible youth are grouped based on travel accommodations and skill level, and complete lifesaving and lifeguard training on a regular schedule at the Frank J. Dunn Pool and/or Kinsmen Water Park.

## Eligibility:

- 1. Identify as First Nation, Inuit, or Metis (status/non-status).
- 2. Aged 15+.
- 3. Complete mandatory in-water screening.
