**PROGRAM FUNDING AGREEMENT**

WHEREAS WR-2 wishes to grant certain moneys for the purposes of facilitating the Grantee in operating a lifeguard training program;

NOW, THEREFORE, WR-2 does make a grant to the Grantee upon the following terms and conditions:

1. WR-2 hereby grants to the Grantee a sum not exceeding \$60000.00 herein referred to as "the Grant Moneys" on the terms and conditions provided in this Agreement.
2. The Grantee agrees to use the Grant Moneys only for the operating the free lifeguard training program described on Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this Agreement, hereafter referred to as the "program" respectively.
3. In respect of program funds, prior to the deadline date the Grantee agrees to provide WR-2 with evidence of successful completion of the program including program evaluation, financial information and other documentation in a form acceptable to the Metis Central Western Region II. If the full amount in (1) is not used, that money can be transferred back to the Western Region II.

4. The Grantee agrees that in the event that its activities change, are suspended for a period in excess of two months or are terminated, the Grantee shall forthwith give notice of same to the Regional Director, Sherry McLennan of the WR-2. Any unused funds shall be returned from the Grantee to WR-2.

Project: Lifeguard Training Program

Description: This program offers free lifesaving and lifeguard training to eligible youth and young adults from Western Region 2.

The program encompasses two streams:

1. Mainstream: Eligible youth apply to have fees waived for regularly scheduled lifesaving and lifeguard training held at the Frank J. Dunn Swimming Pool and/or Kinsmen Water Park.
2. Group: Eligible youth are grouped based on travel accommodations and skill level, and complete lifesaving and lifeguard training on a regular schedule at the Frank J. Dunn Pool and/or Kinsmen Water Park.

Eligibility:

1. Identify as First Nation, Inuit, or Metis (status/non-status).
2. Aged 15+.
3. Complete mandatory in-water screening.
