At this time the Historical Society will be speaking about,

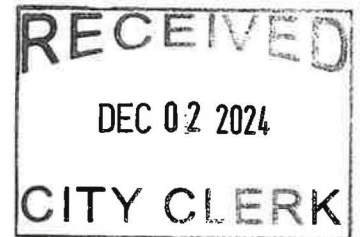
- The partnership and Memorandum of Agreement between the Society and City

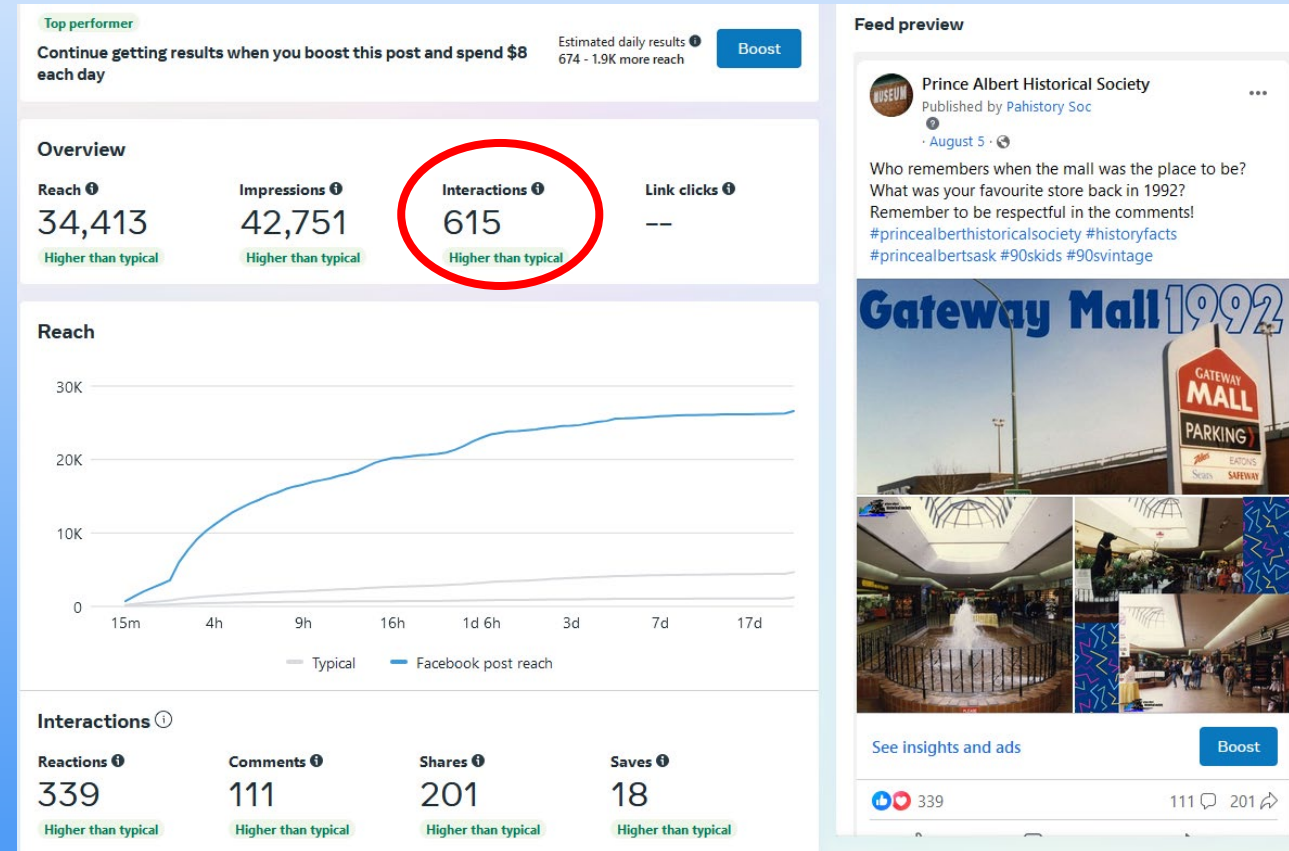
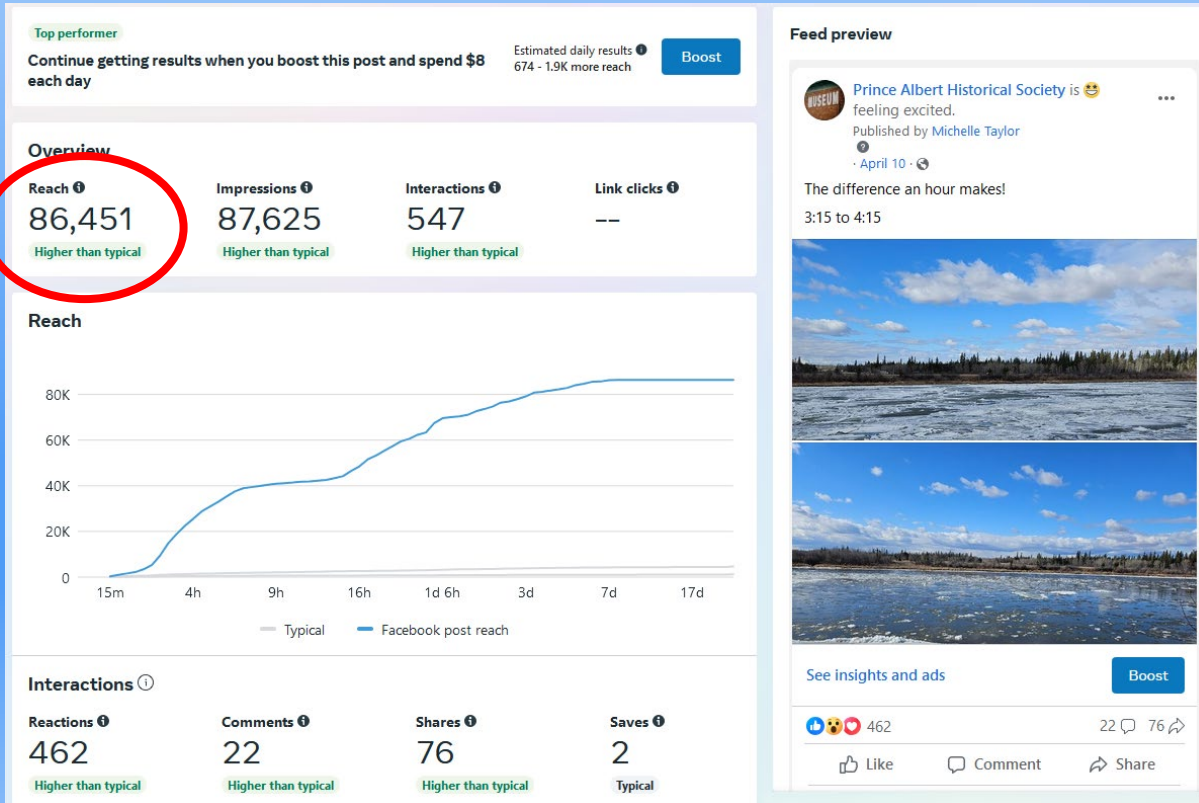
